imagine what atari might have achieved if steve jobs had stayed there to develop the first massmarket personal computer or what steve case might have done for pepsico if he hadn t left for a gaming start up that eventually became aol what if salomon brothers had kept michael bloomberg or bear stearns had exploited the inventive ideas of stephen ross scores of top tier entrepreneurs worked for established corporations before they struck out on their own and became self made billionaires people like mark cuban john paul dejouria sara blakely and t boone pickens all built businesses in some cases multiple businesses that are among today s most iconic brands this fact raises two profound questions why couldn t their former employers hang on to to these extraordinarily talented people and why are most big companies unable to create as much new value as the world s roughly 800 self made billionaires john sviokla and mitch cohen decided to look more closely at self made billionaires because creating 1 billion or more in value is an incredible feat drawing on extensive research and
