identification based on activists' constructions of modernity throughout the text she does not demonstrate how activists' conceptualizations of modernity reflect western academic discourses of modernity rather it is her intent to unfold and illustrate a vernacular palestinian and activist discourse of modernity exploring how modernity here is literally an ideology in the making and subject to improvisation still these same improvisations carry social weight within the activist community as activists reflect on their roles as emergent modern leaders as well as judge others with reference to these same ideologies
